





For pick up, drivers should drive as far as the rear of the parish office building forming three (3) lines. Students are to be picked up in front of the Parish Hall.


Drivers who must wait for students who are delayed will be directed to park in the spaces behind the church. NO PARKING for pick-up is allowed in the east driveway.



- 5. Parents bringing lunches to school must drop them off by 11:30 am.











## Anti-Bullying and Harassment Policy

St. Rose of Lima School is dedicated to ensuring a safe and respectful environment for all students. The school strictly prohibits any behavior that negatively impacts a student's academic performance or creates an intimidating or hostile educational atmosphere.

#### **Definition of Bullying**

Bullying involves the chronic use of power to control, demean, embarrass, or harm another individual or group. It can be:

- Physical: Hitting, kicking, spitting, destroying property.
- Verbal: Taunting, name-calling, insults, threats.
- Emotional: Spreading rumors, excluding activities, humiliation, intimidation.
- Cyberbullying: Using electronic means to harass or threaten.

#### **Prohibited Conduct**

Examples include:

- Physical violence
- Intimidation or threats
- Stalking
- Property damage or theft
- Teasing, taunting, name-calling
- Social isolation or exclusion
- Public humiliation
- Spreading rumors or gossip
- Harassing messages or posts online

#### Reporting and Response

- Staff must be alert to signs of bullying, document incidents, and act promptly.
- Bullying incidents should be reported by students or parents to a staff member.
- The principal will investigate and document incidents, notify parents, and determine consequences based on severity.

#### **Disciplinary Actions**

Depending on the severity and prior behavior, consequences may include:

Warnings and documentation

- Detention
- Written contract
- Counseling
- Meeting with the School Leadership Team
- Suspension
- Withdrawal or expulsion

Bullying at school events or off-campus, when verified, will be addressed similarly.

#### **Harassment Policy**

St. Rose of Lima School is committed to a harassment-free environment. Harassment by any student, employee, or clergy member is prohibited. Allegations will be investigated promptly, confidentially, and thoroughly.

#### **Definition of Harassment**

Harassment includes hostile or intimidating treatment based on race, creed, color, national origin, physical disability, or sex. It can occur at school, home, or online. Forms of harassment include:

- Virtual Harassment: Online bullying, spreading rumors, sending threats.
- Verbal Harassment: Derogatory comments, jokes, threats.
- Physical Harassment: Unwanted touching, assault, blocking movement.
- Visual Harassment: Derogatory posters, cartoons, gestures.
- Sexual Harassment: Unwelcome sexual advances, propositions, comments, or conduct affecting academic status or creating a hostile environment.

#### Responsibilities

- Inform all faculty, staff, students, and parents about the policy and its importance.
- Immediately address and report any discriminatory or harassing behavior.
- Ensure that the behavior is discontinued immediately if someone is informed it is offensive.

The school takes all allegations seriously and will take disciplinary action, up to dismissal, for substantiated harassment or false allegations.
