### ATTENTION!!!! UNIFORM SHOE REQUIREMENT

Solid black or white shoes with white or black trim only. No patterns or designs. No Velcro.

- 3 small glue sticks
- 1-emergency kit (small snack, non-perishable, 1-water bottle, note of comfort from you)
- Student last name A-H One pack of colored paper (computer-type) 8 1/2 x 11"
- Student last name I-P one pack Paper Mate Flair colored felt pens
- Student last name Q-Z White out correction roller tape
- 1-backpack. **NO** rolling backpacks, **please**

Check boxes on right for art and science lab supplies needed. Send these in clearly marked for art, with your child's name on them. All supplies should be on hand the first day of school so that students are ready to work! Please label folder,
